Proposal:

In the Government Order read at (1) above, A State Level Nodal Agency (SLNA) for implementation of Watershed Development Programmes was constituted as per the Common Guidelines of Watershed Development Projects 2008.

In the Proceedings of Twelfth Meeting of State Level Nodal Agency (SLNA) Committee read at (2) above, held under the Chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary and Development commissioner, Government of Karnataka, it was decided to reorganize the entire State Level Nodal Agency (SLNA) Committee. by including the members from various other related line Departments, Institutions, Universities and representatives of reputed NGOs.

Accordingly, the Commissioner for Watershed Development Department vide his letter dated 25.05.2019 read at (3) above, has requested to re-constitute the State Level Nodal Agency for the implementation of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayi Yojana-watershed Development programmes in Karnataka which is sponsored by Government of India.

The Term of the Non official member shall be for a period of one year and may be continued by a separate Order.

Roles and Responsibilities of the Committee:

- a. Prepare State Perspective and Strategic Plan (SPSP) for Watershed Development of the State on the basis of plans prepared at the block and district levels and indicate implementation strategies and expected outputs/outcomes, financial outlays and approach the Nodal Agency at the Central level in the department of appraisal and clearance.
- b. Establish and maintain a State Level Data Cell from the funds sanctioned by the Government of India and connect it on line with the National Level Data Center.
- c. Provide technical support to the Watershed Cell cum Data Center (WCDCs)/Joint Director of Agriculture Throughout the state.
- d. Approve the Preliminary Project Reports and Detailed Project Reports.
- e. Approve a list of independent institutions for capacity building of various stake holders within the State and workout the overall capacity building strategy.
- f. Approve the identified Project Implementing Agencies (PIAs) recommended by the District Level Committee headed by CEO, ZP by adopting an appropriate objective selection criteria.
- g. Establish Monitoring Evaluation. Learning and Documentation systems at various levels (internal and external / independent systems).
- h. Ensure regular and quality on line monitoring of watershed projects in the State in association with the Nodal Agency at the Central level and by securing feedback in developing partnerships with independent and capable agencies.
- i. Recommend a panel of independent institutional evaluators for all watershed projects within the State to the Central Agency.
- j. Prepare State specific process guidelines, operational and Technical manuals etc. in co-ordination with the Nodal Ministry and operationalize the same.
- k. Prepare a convergence plan with the existing State and Central sponsored programme to saturate the watersheds.
- l. The SLNA shall meet at least once in every six months.
