PREAMBLE:

In the letter read at (1), the Ministry of Food Processing Industries (MFPI) has launched new Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), National Mission on Food Processing (NMFP) during the 12th Five Year plan to be implemented through States. The proposed NMFP contemplates establishment of a National Mission as well as corresponding Missions in the State and District level. This scheme is proposed to be implemented as a new centrally sponsored scheme in the ratio of 75:25 by Government of India and States. The State during the budget year 2012-13 has created a new Head of Account (2401-00-102-0-07 (059)) to receive the grants from Government of India and has provided a matching grants of Rs. 500 lakh in the Budget.

The proceedings of the meeting held under the chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary and Development Commissioner on 07-02-2012 read at (2), regarding allocation of food processing sector to Agriculture Department (Food Processing Sector) highlights that the Department of Agriculture will be the State Mission Directorate of Food Processing Sector and the Director of Agriculture will be the State Mission Director and Karnataka Agricultural Produce Processing and Export Corporation limited (KAPPEC) will be the State Nodal Agency with effect from 01-04-2012:

The Important components to be implemented under the scheme are :

- Technology up gradation/Setting up/Modernization of food processing Industries.
- Cold chain, value addition and preservation infrastructure for nonhorticultural produce.
- 3. Modernization of Abattoirs
- 4. Human resource development
- 5. Scheme for promotion of food processing sector.

The Director of Agriculture in the proposal read at (3) has requested to issue the Government order for implementation of the new Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), National Mission on Food Processing (NMFP).

The Planning Department and Finance Department has concurred the new Centrally Sponsored Scheme National Mission on Food Processing (NMFP) for the year 2012-13.

Hence, this order

ORDER

Sanction is hereby accorded for implementation of new Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS), National Mission on Food Processing (NMFP) in the state. The Director of Agriculture is nominated as the State Mission Director for implementation of the scheme as per the guidelines issued by Government of India. The Department of Agriculture shall function as the State Mission Directorate for Food Processing Sector and Karnataka Agricultural Produce Processing and Export Corporation limited (KAPPEC) shall be the State Nodal Agency for Food Processing with effect from 01.04.2012.

The Central and the State share for implementation will be in the ratio of 75:25 and the expenditure under the scheme to be borne under the state head of account 2401-00-102-0-07 (059). The Department of Agriculture is directed to

implement the scheme with the budget provision not exceeding Rs.500.00 lakhs as the State Government share during the year 2012-13
